We have received notification from the National Center for Import and Export that your facility located at **60 Industrial Park Road, Saco, Maine, 04072**, has been granted approval number **ME-TEC-0004** as being compliant with EC Regulation 1774/2002 as currently amended.

Please note the following qualifications:

- \*\* All Processed Ruminant Material must be presented with results of safety tests or exported directly to an approved establishment in the EU for further processing.
- \*\*\*"Untreated" ruminant materials may not be directly exported until the EU considers the U.S. free of Vesicular Stomatitis.

In order to maintain this approval, the facility must be inspected and found compliant with EC Regulation 1774/2002 as amended, annually.
